Veteran controversial host to the Globes, **Ricky Gervais**, opened the show by explaining how he was offered the hosting gig again, after brutally insulting the star-studded audience last year. "The Hollywood Foreign Press have warned me that if I insult any of you, or any of them, or offend any viewers or cause any controversy whatsoever, they'll definitely invite me back next year as well." The trash-talking host continued making jokes throughout the night, even targeting the Golden Globes themselves: "For any of you who don't know, the Golden Globes are just like the Oscars, but without all that esteem. The Golden Globes are to the Oscars what **Kim Kardashian** is to **Kate Middleton** — A bit louder, a bit trashier, a bit drunker, and more easily bought."

After Gervais's first round of jokes were out of the way, the first trophy of the night went to 82-year-old **Christopher Plummer**, who earned his first-ever Golden Globe for Best Supporting Actor in a Motion Picture (*Beginners*).

Helen Mirren and Sidney Poitier were on hand to present Hollywood powerhouse **Morgan Freeman** with the Cecil B. DeMille Award for Lifetime Achievement.
